Statewide Peer Review

Thank you for your participation in Statewide Peer Review! The program continues to grow, and as such, we are anticipating making some changes to better align with other peer review models across the country.

1. Cohort Based Model with Facilitator

There will be cohorts of up to 10 participants in each. Each cohort will be facilitated by a trainer from the Wisconsin Forensic Interview Guidelines (WI-FIG).

CACs of Wisconsin (the Chapter) will continue with all administrative duties for peer review and the primary contact for any questions is Elizabeth Champion, <u>elizabeth@cacsofwi.org</u>.

2. Participant Requirements

As before, participants must have completed a 32-hour forensic interview training program approved by the National Children's Alliance (such as WI-FIG, Cornerhouse, Finding Words, APSAC, etc.) and must be conducting forensic interviews. The presenter can also choose to invite the rest of their multidisciplinary team to their presentation only. The MDT members must sign a confidentiality agreement.

We ask that participants plan on attending at least 80% of scheduled sessions. We understand that, especially in this work, there are emergent issues that may prevent attendance. However, for the best success of the cohort model, it is essential to ensure that there is adequate attendance. Attendance will be tracked via a Google Form, along with a confidentiality agreement at the beginning of each meeting.

If several interviewers from your organization or MDT are planning to sign up, we highly recommend signing up for different cohorts, as you will be able to bring different perspectives back to your team.

Each participant must sign up to present an interview during the next year. If you do not currently have an interview to show, please sign up for a later date. Sign up links are below:
